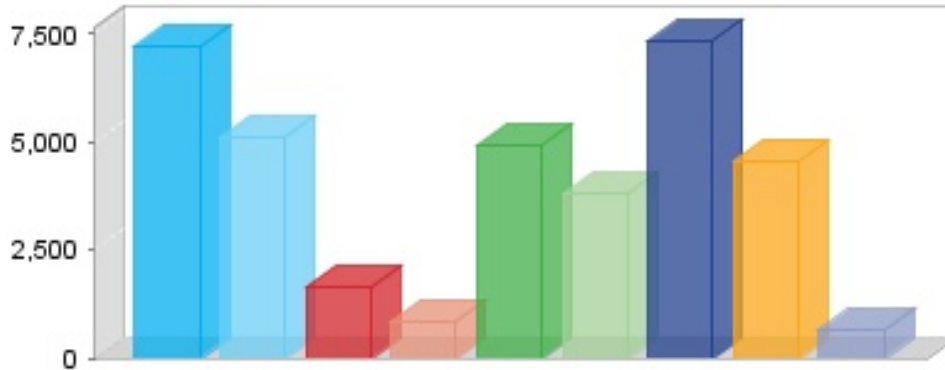

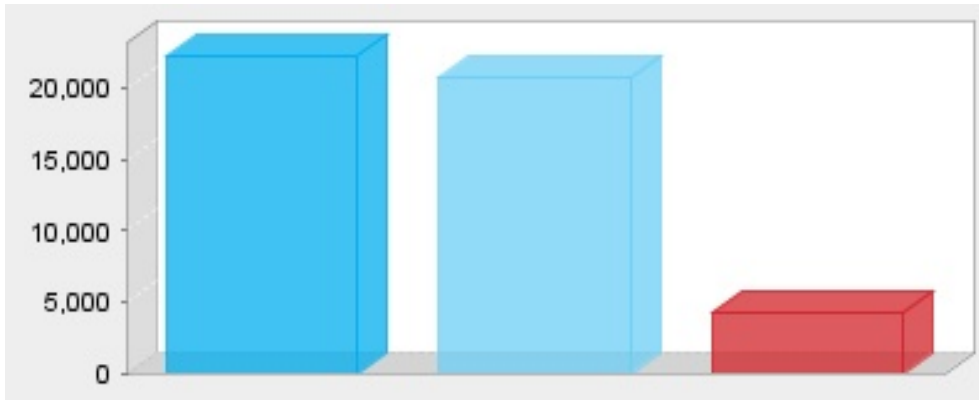

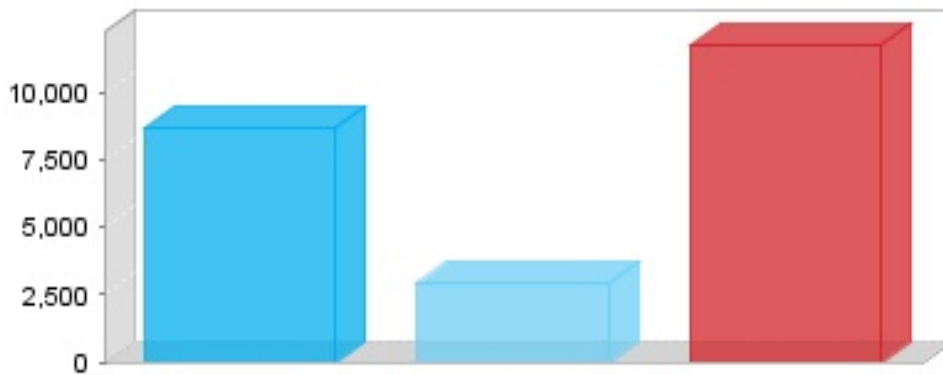

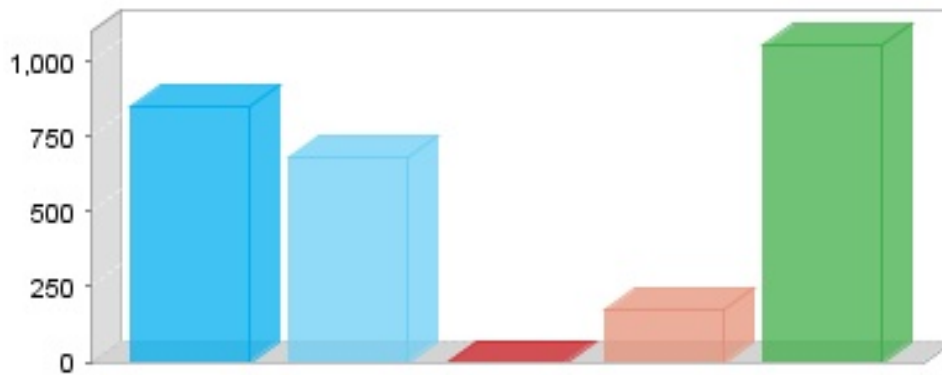

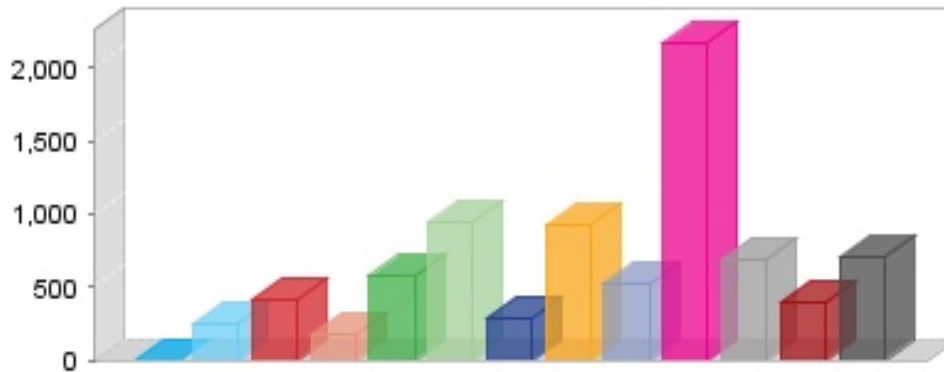

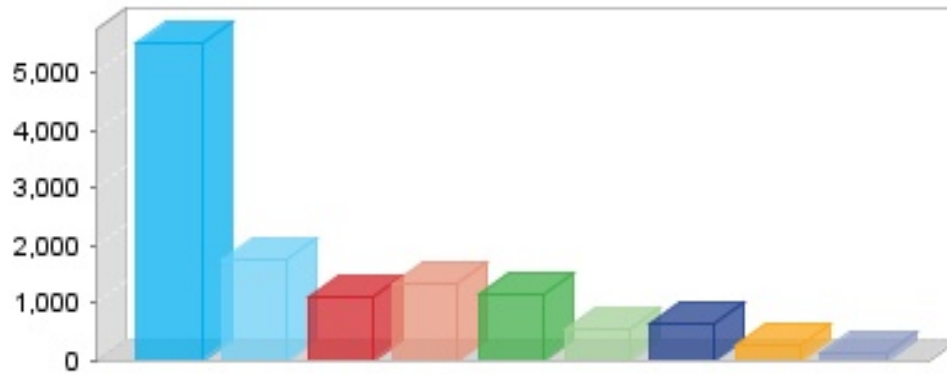
### Poverty Status (below poverty level)

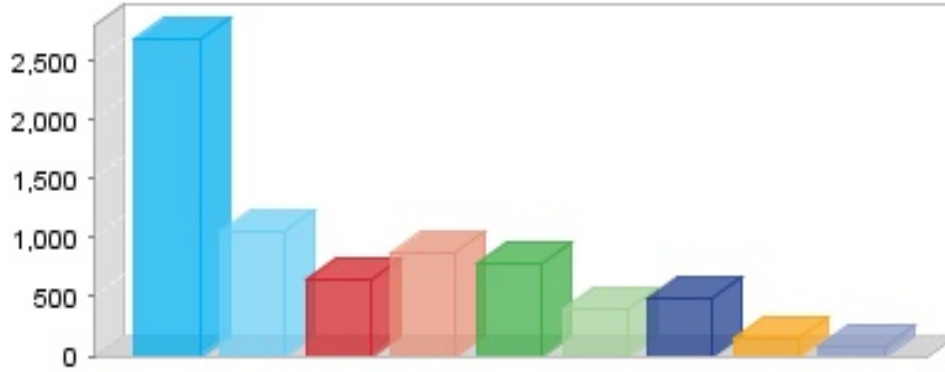

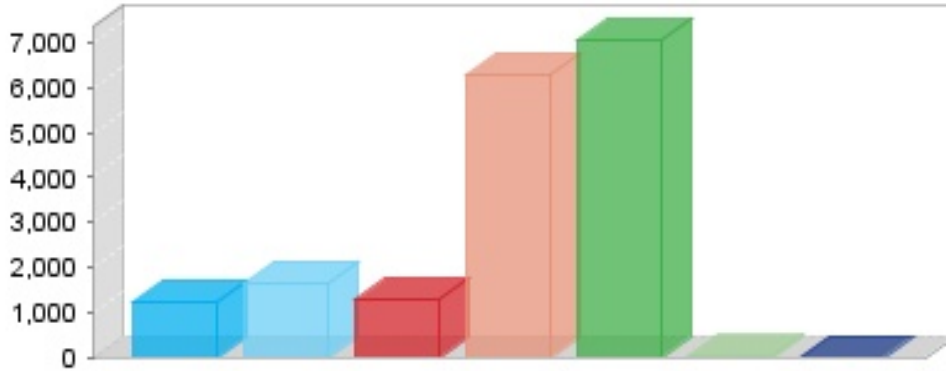

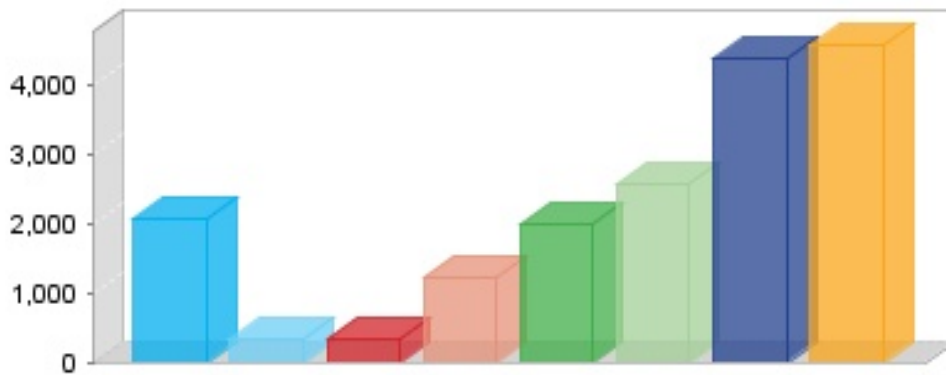

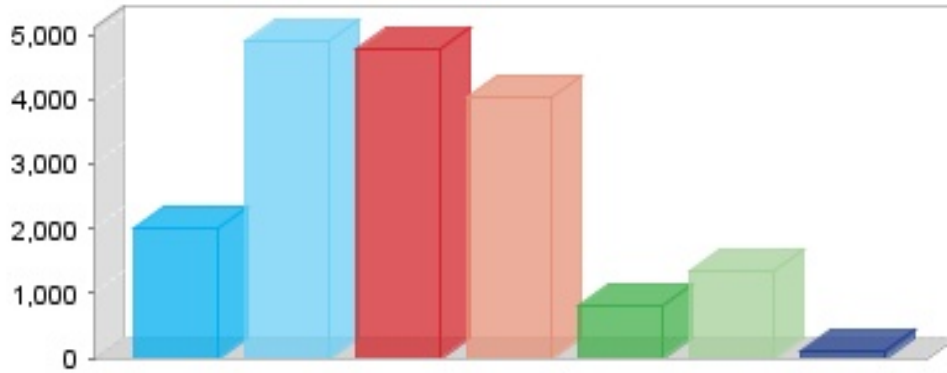

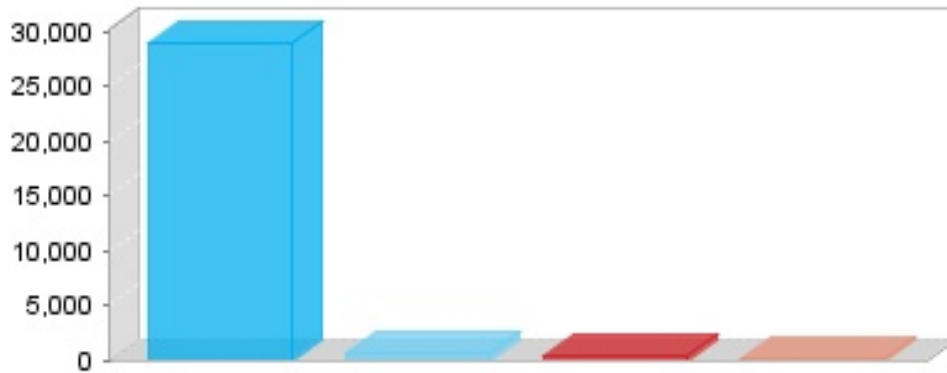
